 Makerere, Muhimbili, Moi, Nairobi, Jimma, Kinshasa, Rwanda SOPH






Objectives of the Alliance

Major Public Health Challenges in East Africa



- A high burden of preventable: HIV, TB, Malaria
- A severe shortage of human resources with leadership skills; fragmented health systems
- High demand for public health leadership training but no space

A case for Open Education Resources in East Africa

- All member schools offer an MPH developed from a shared context

- Teaching methods still largely traditional

 - The students will be involved in generating case studies/experiences that can be posted and accessed by other students






Alliance to lead the region in developing high-quality OER

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

 - OER Africa (Neil Butcher, Tony Mays)





- Commercial learning resources too costly for students
- Quality reusable learning resources available but not developed/not shared
